ALBERTA ELECTORAL BOUNDARIES COMMISSION: AAMDC Briefing on the Alberta Electoral Boundary Review

The **Alberta Electoral Boundaries Commission** (AEBC) has been tasked with reviewing the existing boundaries and names for the 87 electoral constituencies. As part of the review process, stakeholders are able to provide comment through written or in-person submissions. The process by which those comments can be received is now **online**.

The AAMDC has developed a **submission** to the AEBC which is available **here**. The submission speaks to the need to ensure “effective representation” for all Albertans. President, Al Kemmere, will be presenting to the AEBC on Monday, January 16th, 2017 and this submission will guide that presentation.

As part of the review process, public hearings such as the one the AAMDC is presenting at will be held between January 16, 2017 and February 24, 2017. The schedule for those hearings can be found **here**. Please note that those wishing to make a presentation must register in advance. Please see the **AEBC website** for the registration details.
