

NEW MGA TOOLS - Councillor Code of Conduct: A Guide for Municipalities

The AAMDC, in partnership with the Alberta Urban Municipalities Association and Alberta Municipal Affairs, is pleased to announce the release of a tool for municipalities to implement the recent changes to the *Municipal Government Act* (MGA). The ***Councillor Code of Conduct: A Guide for Municipalities*** is a tool to help municipalities develop their local codes of conduct (S. 146).

The revised MGA requires all municipalities to develop a council code of conduct; however, the province has left the details of each municipality's code of conduct to be determined locally.

The resource is broken into two parts. The first part is an explanation of codes of conduct and what the legislative amendments require. The second part is an actual template that municipalities can use and adapt to their local context. The AAMDC encourages members to use this resource to help develop their local councillor codes of conduct.
