Discover What's Happening at the Spring 2018 Convention!

The **AAMDC Spring 2018 Convention**, scheduled for March 19-21, is fast approaching and is sure to be another great event. For a complete convention agenda information, **click here**.

The **trade show** will kick things off on March 19 with 165 exhibitors featuring approved suppliers, government agencies, and a variety of other companies and organizations. AAMDC will have staff on hand to showcase our Trade Division, External Relations and Advocacy Department, Jubilee Insurance and PFA.

The convention program is packed on Tuesday, March 20 with keynote speaker Kelly Lendsay and plenary addresses from the Federation of Canadian Municipalities, Minister of Municipal Affairs, Minister of Infrastructure, and RCMP. The **resolution session** will run in the afternoon followed by **workshops**, including:
