

Register for the EOEP's Upcoming Courses

The Elected Officials Education Program (EOEP), a joint venture of the AAMDC and AUMA, is Alberta's only professional education program designed for municipally elected officials.

The EOEP will introduce a brand-new series of courses in following the upcoming municipal election in fall 2017. The new EOEP will be led by Munis 101, which will provide both new and returning elected officials with the skills and knowledge that they need to excel in their positions. Munis 101 will meet Municipal Affairs mandatory training requirements under the revised Municipal Government Act.
