Petition to Government of Canada Requesting Tax Credits for Volunteer Citizens on Patrol Open for Signature

An e-petition calling on the Government of Canada to extend a \$3000 tax credit to volunteer citizens on Patrol is now open for signature on the [Government of Canada's website](#). The petition calls for a tax credit similar to that currently available to volunteer fire fighters and search and rescue volunteers, to be applied to citizens on patrol. This may act as a way to better support current citizens on patrol and as an incentive for those who may be interested in volunteering.
