## **AAMDC Submission on Species at Risk Policies**

The implications of the *Species at Risk Act* (SARA) has been identified as a priority by AAMDC members through the endorsement of several resolutions. The AAMDC recently provided a submission to the Government of Canada regarding seven draft policies, which support consistent implementation of SARA. These draft policies are:

- Policy on Critical Habitat Protection on Non-federal Lands
- Policy on Protecting Critical Habitat with Conservation Agreements under Section 11 of the Species at Risk Act
- Policy on Survival and Recovery
- Policy Regarding the Identification of Anthropogenic Structures as Critical Habitat under the Species at Risk Act
- Approach to the Identification of Critical Habitat under the Species at Risk Act when Habitat Loss is Not Believed to be a Significant Threat to the Survival or Recovery of the Species
- Species at Risk Act Permitting Policy
- Listing policy for Terrestrial Species at Risk

The AAMDC would like to thank members who provided information to support the AAMDC's submission.
