

FCM's Climate and Asset Management Network Now Taking Applications

Applications are now open for FCM's [Climate and Asset Management Network](#), which provides peer-learning opportunities, grant funding, and training to help municipalities better integrate climate and sustainability goals into asset management approaches. Participants in the Network will:

- Have access to funding up to \$175,000 to support eligible asset management initiatives.
- Collaborate closely with other municipalities from across Canada.
- Be connected to a national network of professionals and asset management resources.

The deadline to apply is **June 15, 2017**.

The network is designed for municipalities that are working to address climate change and want to better integrate climate change goals with decision-making about infrastructure assets and services, such as roads, buildings, drinking water and sanitation. Network participants will benefit from funding of up to \$175,000 along with workshops and knowledge-sharing activities with municipalities across Canada.

The Climate and Asset Management Network is offered through FCM's [Municipalities for Climate Innovation Program](#) and funded by the Government of Canada.
