

Transport Canada Consulting on Marine Safety and Crude Oil Tankers

As part of a broader effort to plan for the future of Canada's transportation network, the Government of Canada is currently inviting stakeholder input on marine safety and a crude oil tanker moratorium on British Columbia's north coast.

While these issues do not **directly** impact rural Alberta, both have the potential to impact the movement of natural resources originating in Alberta to global markets.
