

Fall 2016 Resolution Deadline Approaching

The deadline to submit resolutions for the fall 2016 convention is <u>Monday, October 17, 2016</u>. Any resolutions submitted after this deadline will need to meet the definition of "emergent" as identified in the **AAMDC's resolution process policy**.

What makes a good AAMDC resolution?

- Resolutions should address issues that are provincial in scope and not focus on local issues.
- Resolutions should influence legislative changes that will impact rural municipalities.
- The issue identified in a resolution should clearly demonstrate that the AAMDC is the best organization to advocate on moving it forward.
- The structure of resolutions is important. They **<u>must have</u>** a title, preamble, operative clause and member background.
- Members are encouraged to review the AAMDC's **Resolution Writing Tips**.

Complete, district-approved **resolutions meeting the above requirements** <u>MUST be emailed in a</u> <u>Microsoft Word format</u> to tasha@aamdc.com by the aforementioned deadline.
