

## Sign up for FREE Asset Management Workshops!

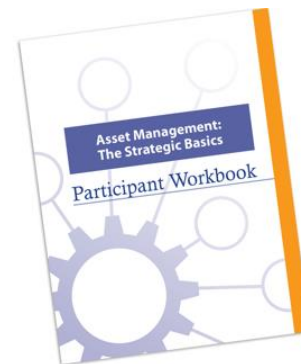
