Training Available for Subdivision and Development Appeal Board (SDAB)

Training for SDAB members and clerks is now available to support mandatory training requirement under the Municipal Government Act (MGA)

Recent changes of the MGA include a **requirement for SDAB members and clerks** to undergo mandatory training based on a standard program to be approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs. SDAB training will ensure that hearing practices are consistent across the province, and board members have a comprehensive understanding of their role and the appeal process.
