History Check becomes an Alberta-wide Heritage & Tourism Mobile App

Friends of Historical Northern Alberta Society (FHNAS) and **Impact Tourism** work to preserve and promote the history of Alberta. In 2017, FHNAS and Impact Tourism launched the History Check app to show the history and uniqueness of northern Alberta's smaller and lesser-known regions. FHNAS and Impact Tourism are excited to announce that **History Check** is now available province-wide!

History Check is an innovative and collaborative project that brings together the resources of municipalities, organizations, Indigenous communities, historical societies, businesses, and non-profits to help promote Alberta and its tourism opportunities.
