Government of Alberta Launches Public Red Tape Reduction Initiative

Albertans can submit their ideas for cutting red tape through email or a fillable form

The Government of Alberta has launched a [red tape reporting website](#) to enable Albertans to suggest red tape reduction opportunities and share their experiences in encountering red tape when interacting with provincial government services or processes. The website is one aspect of the Government of Alberta's overall focus on reducing the regulatory burden on business, and is supported by [Bill 4: the Red Tape Reduction Act](#).
