Government of Alberta to Host Webinar on Cannabis Enforcement Costs

The Government of Alberta has begun the process of reviewing municipal costs associated with cannabis legalization. This review was identified as a commitment in the [UCP election platform](#).

The intent of the review is to better understand enforcement (and potentially other) costs incurred by municipal governments as a result of the legalization of recreational cannabis in October 2018. RMA hopes the review will help to inform a fair and consistent provincial-municipal revenue-sharing model for the cannabis excise tax revenues that the Government of Alberta (along with all provinces and territories) receives from the Government of Canada.
