The WildTrax team is hosting a webinar on November 27

WildTrax is a new online platform for storing, managing, processing, and sharing biological data collected by environmental sensors that was created by representatives from the **Alberta Biodiversity Monitoring Institute (ABMI)** and the **Bioacoustic Unit** at the University of Alberta. Users can upload their data, take advantage of sophisticated AI-based automatic processing tools to classify observations, and discover new data or share their own.

The WildTrax team is continuously improving the platform and are currently working on developing a data discovery map, a citizen-science version of the platform that will allow anyone to help crowdsource data processing.
