Apply for the Wetland Replacement Program

Alberta Environment and Parks has released a new factsheet for the Wetland Replacement Program

Alberta Environment and Parks (AEP) has funding available for eligible wetland replacement projects and is seeking to establish partnerships with municipalities. **The Wetland Replacement Program** (WRP) aims to re-establish wetlands in partnership with Albertans by providing resources for collaborative restoration projects across the province. WRP will focus on fostering partnerships with municipalities that have a vested interest in wetland replacement, which includes the following:

- **Wetland Restoration:** Returning natural/historic functions to a former or degraded wetland.
- **Wetland Construction:** Creating a wetland on a site that was historically a non-wetland.

Municipalities that are interested in identifying and managing wetland replacement projects within their municipality and meet the minimum pre-qualification requirements are eligible to apply for the 2020/21 program.
