FCM announces new funding for municipalities to help deliver energy efficient financing programs for low-rise residential properties.

The **Federation of Canadian Municipalities** (FCM) announced a \$300 million dollar **Community Efficiency Financing** initiative under the **Green Municipal Fund** to help municipalities deliver energy efficient financing programs for low-rise residential properties, including Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) models and utility on-bill financing.

The FCM funding and learning resources can help municipalities achieve the following:

- Create, launch, and expand innovative financing programs for residential energy projects.
- Generate triple bottom line benefits such as:
 - Reduce greenhouse gas emissions, create energy savings, and contribute to climate adaptation, water conservation, and health and safety outcomes.
 - Accelerate energy cost savings, improve housing affordability, and keep the local economy moving.
 - Increase home comfort, health, and quality of life for residents.
