Alberta Biodiversity Monitoring Institute is seeking input to ensure the Biodiversity Browser better fits wetland stakeholder needs

In 2017, the **Alberta Biodiversity Monitoring Institute** (ABMI) released the **Biodiversity Browser** (BB) as an encyclopedia of life for Alberta plant and wildlife species. The BB has been used to broadly share ABMI data and information on Alberta species to support decision making by land-use managers and policy makers in the province. ABMI, in partnership with **Ducks Unlimited**, is seeking input from stakeholders to help revamp the BB to ensure it better fits wetland stakeholders needs.
