MCCAC to Lead Alberta's Clean Energy Improvement Program

On June 11, 2020, the [Government of Alberta announced](#) that Energy Efficiency Alberta (EEA) will be disbanded, with programming shifted to [Emissions Reduction Alberta](#), the [Municipal Climate Change Action Centre](#) (MCCAC), and [Alberta Environment and Parks](#). Over the next 90 days, the MCCAC will be working closely with the Government of Alberta and EEA to assume responsibility for the [Clean Energy Improvement Program](#) (CEIP).

CEIP is a made in Alberta Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) program that provides residential and commercial property owners with access to competitive, long-term financing to cover up 100% of their project costs with no down payment required.

RMA will update members on MCCAC progress with assuming responsibility for CEIP.
