The federal government has drafted a discussion paper, titled [A proposed integrated management approach to plastic products to prevent waste and pollution](#), and is seeking input on the proposed integrated management approach to plastics. The proposed integrated management approach would implement a number of actions, including regulations, which would be developed under the provisions of the [Canadian Environmental Protection Act](#) (CEPA).
