Environment and Climate Change Canada Releases Technical Guidelines for Environmental Emergency Regulations

In 2019, [Environment and Climate Change Canada's](#) new [Environmental Emergency Regulations](#) came into force replacing the previous version of the Environmental Emergency (E2) Regulations (2011). The ECCC has released the [Technical Guidelines](#) for these regulations to assist regulatees in better understanding the requirements of the regulations so that they are able to comply with the legislation.
