Five-Year Report Update Under the Code of Practice for Pits

Alberta Environment and Parks has modified the process for the review of five-year reports under the [Code of Practice for Pits](#). The changes were made to streamline the review approach and ensure that the report management was consistent for all types of industry. The changes include:

- ◆ Reports will be managed as “reports” and not “applications,” which means that:
 - ◇ The registration number will no longer change when the report is received and reviewed by the department.
 - ◇ Report review letters will not be posted on the Authorization Viewer.
- ◆ All reports must be submitted electronically to AEP.EPEAAPPLICATIONS@gov.ab.ca
