## Alberta Biodiversity Monitoring Institute Launches New Version of Online Mapping Portal

*Alberta Biodiversity Monitoring Institute is hosting a webinar to provide a summary of new version of their online mapping portal*

The [Alberta Biodiversity Monitoring Institute](#) (ABMI) recently launched a new version of their [online mapping portal](#). This mapping portal allows users to pull up a location that interests them and load data layers, such as human footprints, old forest bird habitat suitability, or predicted hotspots for uncommon species. Users can access a summary of the total human footprint in their area of interest and compare these summary figures over time.
