## Modifications to Schedule 1 of the Species at Risk Act

*Three of species are located within Alberta*

In August 2021, [Environment and Climate Change Canada](#) registered 16 species at risk under the *Species at Risk Act* (SARA). These changes were reported in the [Canada Gazette, part II](#) on September 1, 2021. Of the 16 at risk species, two are found within Alberta:

- ◆ Bullsnake, which is categorized as special concern.
- ◆ LadyBeetle, Transverse, which is categorized as special concern.
