Watershed Resiliency and Restoration Program Application Period Extended

The deadline for applications has been extended to November 30

The [Watershed Resiliency and Restoration Program](#) (WRRP) was established in 2014, in recognition of the importance of improving natural watershed functions to build long-term resiliency for floods and droughts. The WRRP is administered by [Alberta Environment and Parks](#) (AEP) and provides grants to municipalities and organizations for the design and construction of projects that enhance watershed resiliency impacts from flooding and droughts.

WRRP is accepting applications for grant funding for projects that will build long-term resiliency to flood and drought events. The primary objective of the WRRP is to increase the natural ability of Alberta's watersheds to reduce the intensity, magnitude, duration, and effects of flooding and drought through natural watershed mitigation measures.
