## RMA Assigns Statuses to Spring 2022 Resolutions

Following the endorsement of resolutions by RMA members, the RMA forwards the resolutions to the appropriate provincial or federal ministry or organization for an initial response. Based on the response received, the RMA assigns the resolution a status and drafts an initial reaction.

The RMA updates the [resolutions database](#) and issues bulletins with updates as responses are received. The RMA has received additional responses to two member resolutions passed at the spring convention in 2022. Given these responses, the RMA has drafted an initial reaction to two resolutions.
