Munis 101 lays the foundation for elected officials

The [Elected Officials Education Program \(EOEP\)](#), in partnership with Alberta Municipal Affairs, is delivering a virtual offering of Munis 101 to help municipalities meet [Municipal Government Act \(MGA\) orientation requirements](#). This is an excellent opportunity for elected officials who were elected in a by-election to experience this foundational training. Although Munis 101 is mainly intended for councillors, CAOs are encouraged to attend to supplement the topics covered with municipal-specific information. Munis 101 is also the foundational course for the [Municipal Elected Leaders Certificate](#), which the EOEP bestows in partnership with the University of Alberta's Augustana Extended Education program on councillors who complete all seven EOEP courses.
