RMA Assigns Statuses to Several Spring 2022 and Fall 2022 Resolutions

Immediately after resolutions are endorsed by RMA members, the RMA sends the resolutions to the relevant provincial or federal ministry or organization for an initial response. Based on the response received, the RMA assigns the resolution a status and drafts an initial reaction.

The RMA updates the [resolutions database](#) and issues bulletins with updates as responses are received. The RMA has received responses to several member resolutions passed at the 2022 Fall Convention and one member resolution passed at the 2022 Spring Convention. Given these responses, the RMA has drafted an initial reaction to the resolutions.
