## **One Emergent Resolution Added to Fall 2023 Order Paper**

To this point, the RMA has received one emergent resolution. The RMA's Resolutions Committee has determined that the submitted resolution meets the criteria for emergent resolutions, as outlined in section E of RMA's Resolutions Process Policy. As a result, the resolution has been added to the Order Paper and will be debated at next week's RMA convention:

## ER1-23F Limiting Third-party Services in ICF Agreements (Cardston County)

In addition to viewing the resolution on the resolutions database, it will also be available next week on the RMA convention app, and hard copies will be circulated on convention tables prior to the resolutions session.

The RMA's Resolution Process policy defines an emergent resolution as a resolution submitted to the RMA after the resolution deadline - October 10, 2023 for the 2023 Fall Convention - that addresses a subject or problem that has arisen subsequent to the resolution deadline.

There is still time to submit additional emergent resolutions for consideration by the Resolutions Committee. **Emergent resolutions must be submitted prior to 2:00 pm on Tuesday, November 7, 2023**. Any resolutions not received by this deadline will not be reviewed by the Resolutions Committee.

Emergent resolutions, along with an accompanying letter explaining why the resolution should meet the emergent resolutions criteria, must be submitted in Microsoft Word format to RMA Manager of Policy and Advocacy, Wyatt Skovron at wyatt@RMAlberta.com.
