RMA Assigns Statuses to Five Fall 2023 Resolutions

Immediately after resolutions are endorsed by RMA members, the RMA sends the resolutions to the relevant provincial or federal ministry or organization for an initial response. Based on the response received, the RMA assigns the resolution a status and drafts an initial reaction.

The RMA updates the [resolutions database](#) and issues bulletins with updates as responses are received. The RMA has recently received responses to five member resolutions passed at the 2023 Fall Convention. Given these responses, the RMA has drafted an initial reaction to the resolutions.
